In 1934, the department of social and humanitarian sciences began its activity within the departments established at the "Tashkent Institute of Irrigation and Agricultural Mechanization Engineers" National Research University. Since December 1964, the department of social and humanitarian sciences "History", "Philosophy", "Sociology" departments were established. Candidate of History Department, Associate Professor N.Sh. Inoyatov in 1970-1980, Associate Professor E.H. Yerzin in 1980-1990, A.K. Afanasev, the first head of the Department of Philosophy (since 1964), Associate Professor F.G. Malakhin of the Department of Sociology in 1971-1976 presided over. From the first year of our national independence until September 2004, the departments "History of Uzbekistan", "Philosophy" and "Theory and practice of building a democratic society in Uzbekistan" were operating in the institute. In October 2004, these departments were united and the "Humanities" department was established. All social and humanitarian sciences are taught at the department and research work is carried out on them. The professors and teachers of the department are conducting scientific-research work at the expense of the state budget on the topics "The history of the formation and development of the irrigation system in Central Asia" and "Characteristics of the manifestation of

spiritual and moral threats in the process of globalization". In order to develop educational and scientific research activities, the department has established cooperation with the National University of Uzbekistan, Tashkent State Pedagogical University, Tashkent State Agrarian University and the Institute of History of the Academy of Sciences of Uzbekistan. The department works with Yunusabad and Inter house academic lyceums under the institute to organize educational and practical work. Based on the nature of the subjects taught in the department, professors and teachers of the department are constantly engaged in organizing and conducting all spiritual and educational events held in the institute and student residences. Today, a total of 16, namely: 2 professors, 4 associate professors, 2 candidates of science (senior teacher), 3 senior teachers, 5 assistants are working in the department.
